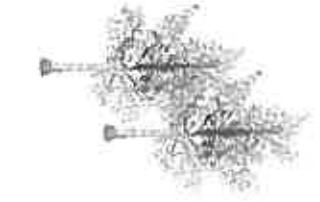
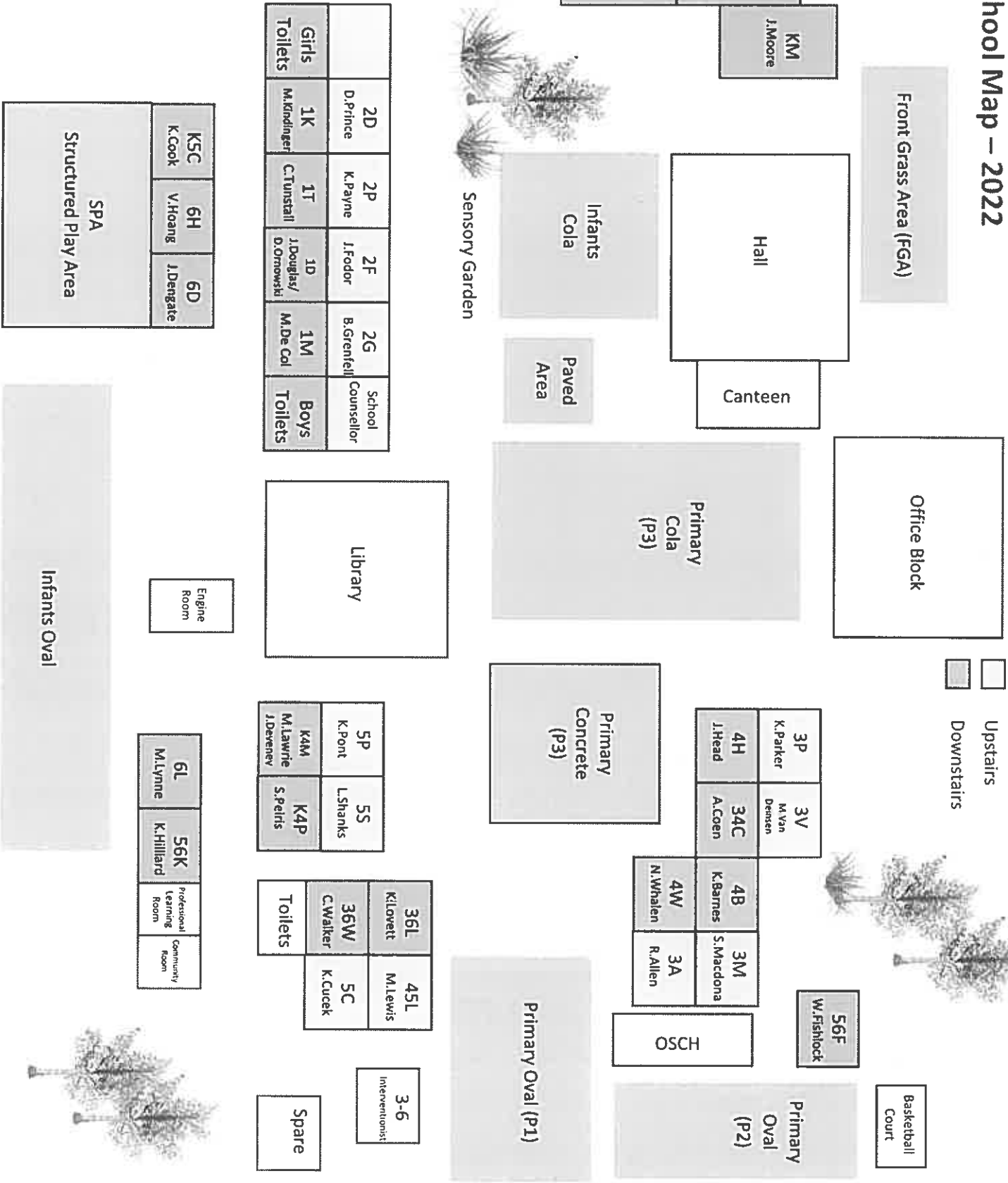

Uniform:

Thank you for supporting the school and ensuring that your child attends school each day in full school uniform including school hat. Our school uniform can be purchased from The Uniform Patch, Campbelltown. We look forward to seeing your child at school every day in full school uniform to maximise their learning and to take part in all school events.

Attendance:

If your child is absent from school, you are required, by law, to provide a written explanation of absence the following day. Please be vigilant with this. If your child arrives at school late, or needs to depart school early, they need to be signed in and out through the front office. 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Homework Years 3-6 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

Across 3-6, we will be utilising ABC Reading Eggs and Mathletics as the two platforms that students utilise to engage in homework. Having a consistent approach towards homework across the school allows teachers to set tasks for your child at an academically appropriate level. It also means that we develop consistency in homework expectations as students progress throughout each year. **Homework will start in Week 7 of Term 1.**

ABC Reading Eggspress

ABC Reading Eggspress is created by a highly experienced team of Australian primary school teachers, writers and developers to help children become fluent and proficient readers. ABC Reading Eggspress is an interactive platform which helps build reading comprehension as well as other literacy skills such as spelling, grammar and vocabulary.

Mathletics

Mathletics brings classroom practice into the home. Aligned to your local curricula, Mathletics activities are relevant, reinforce lessons learned in school, and help your children gain mastery over maths topics or push ahead of what's being taught. Mathletics also allows the classroom teacher to monitor and view your child's progress throughout each week.
