'Seesaw' App for Parents

The instructions to sign up to Seesaw are below. Your child's class teacher will receive a notification when you have signed up so he/she can start sharing photos or videos of your child's learning. Privacy information regarding the third party server that stores all images is attached.

## iPhone, iPad & Android Phones

- 1. Download "Seesaw Parent and Family" in the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
- 2. Start Seesaw Parent and Family App and tap "Create Account". Scan the QR Code below
- 3. Create an account.

4. Allow notifications if you'd like to be notified when new content has been added to your child's journal.

1. Go to https://app.seesaw.me/s/006-830-509 in any web browser.

2. Choose your child from the class list and create an account.



3. After you've been approved by your child's teacher, you'll get access to their journal.
